

TERMS OF SERVICE

Last Updated: September 30, 2014

The products and services (the “Services”) provided by IAS Information System Inc. (“IAS”, “we”, “us” and terms of similar meaning) to you through this website (the “Site”) are subject to these terms and conditions of use (these “Terms”).

You should read these Terms carefully before using the Services. By subscribing, accessing or using the Services, you, as user (the “User”) of the Services, agree to be legally bound by these Terms. Please do not use the Services if you do not agree with these Terms in their entirety.

IAS reserves the right, at any time and in its sole discretion, to revise, change or modify any of the terms and conditions contained in these Terms. If we do so, a notice will be posted in the Site visible to the Users the next time you access the Services. We will also notify you at the email address you have provided, if any, in your subscription information. Unless otherwise specified, any modifications or revisions will be effective immediately upon their posting on the Site, and your continued use of the Services after such time will constitute your acceptance of such modifications or revisions. If you disagree with any of the changes, you can cancel your account with us without further obligation, except for the amount due for the balance of the billing period in which you cancel your account.

The Services are for your own use only. They are not to be resold, leased or provided in any way to anyone else without the express written consent from IAS.

1. Privacy Policy

IAS has a comprehensive privacy policy in place, available at (the “Privacy Policy”), governing its collection, uses and disclosure of personally identifiable information provided by the Users. By using the Services, you agree to our collection, use and disclosure of such information in accordance with the Privacy Policy.

2. User Data

By subscribing our Services, you agree to provide accurate, current and complete information on you as User as prompted by the subscription form (“User Data”), and to promptly update the User Data to reflect any changes.

3. Account Security and Activities

4. Fees, Charges and Taxes

If they do change, we will give you at least 60 days’ written notice by email and by letter. Your continued use after the expiration of the 60 days will constitute your acceptance of the fee change.

They are protected by Canadian and international copyright laws.

6. Limited License to User
